Dwayne Dillinger provided an update on the mitigation process of the damaged gym floor. Discussion was held.

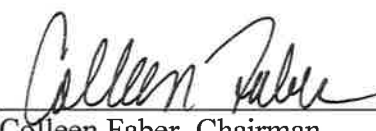
Dwayne Dillinger reported that revenue and usage of the Parks and Rec facilities and programs has increased over prior years.
