- C. Campbell County 4-H 1% grant request

VI. Items from Staff:

A. Recreation Report:

- i. Gibson reported on the following:
 - a. Blades and Avalanche has 40 participants registered for the 1st session. There will also be a 2nd session which will begin on 1/3.
 - b. The Secret Santa program registration began on 11/3 at the Council of Community Services and will continue until 12/2. Currently there are 190 children approved for the program. Staff will begin shopping next week.
 - c. Bantam basketball and Girls 4-6 basketball will be wrapping up on 12/4. There were 587 participants this year.
 - d. There will be a Bench Press competition on 12/10.
 - e. Currently there are 129 patrons pre-registered for the Turkey Trot road race which will be held Thanksgiving morning.
 - f. The Wright staff has been busy with special events. Laser Tag had 53 participants, the dodgeball tournament had 6 teams and 77 children attended the Halloween party.

B. Parks Report:

- i. Geer reported on the following:
 - a. The Festival of Lights display officially opened on 11/19. The display will be open nightly through 1/2.
 - b. Park staff has been decorating trees at the Recreation Center and Lasting Legacy park. The lights will be on nightly beginning 11/26.
 - c. Cam-Plex Park will be closed to traffic on 12/8 and 12/15 from 5-7p.m. as there will be hayrides through the Festival of Lights. This event is sponsored by the KOOL and KOAL radio stations.
 - d. The ice arena will be hosting the fourteenth annual skate around the tree next month. There will be several sessions this year with a limit of 150 participants per session.

C. Bell Nob Report:

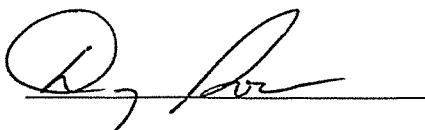
- i. Dillinger reported on the following:

VII. Items from Board: There were no "Items from Board."

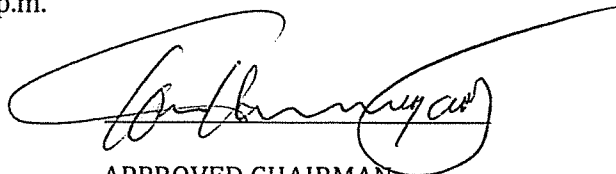
