Special Meeting

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met in a Special Meeting for the purpose of attending the Campbell County Republican Central Committee meeting where the Central Committee is scheduled to select a list of three (3) persons to be considered for the Campbell County Board of Commissioner vacancy. Friday, August 16, 2024, at 5:30 PM.

Present were Jim Ford, Bob Jordan, Kelley McCreery, Commissioners; Sandra Beeman, Executive Director of Administration; Cindy Lovelace, County Clerk; Members of the Campbell County Republican Party Central Committee, Mark Christensen, Scott Clem, Chelsie Collier, Tom Davis, Ben Decker, Gwendolyn Geis, Dale Janota, Robin Kuntz, Candidates; members of the public and members of the press. Commissioner Del Shelstad was absent from the meeting.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance led by Pastor Ed Sisti.

The following candidates for the vacancy on the Board of Commissioners were interviewed by the Republican Central Committee Executive Board: Mark Christensen, Scott Clem, Chelsie Collier, Tom Davis, Ben Decker, Gwendolyn Geis, Dale Janota, Robin Kuntz.

111 ballots were cast by the Campbell County Republican Party Central Committee members resulting in the following vote count for each candidate:

Mark Christensen – 49 votes
Scott Clem – 50 votes
Chelsie Collier – 32 votes
Tom Davis – 22 votes
Ben Decker – 34 votes
Gwendolyn Geis – 38 votes
Dale Janota – 16 votes
Robin Kuntz – 48 votes.

Norberto Orellana, Vice Chairman of the Campbell County Republican Party Central Committee advised that Scott Clem, Mark Christensen, and Robin Kuntz advance to the appointment process by the Board of Commissioners.

No action was taken by the Board of Commissioners. The Commissioners left the meeting at 9:06 PM.
