Commissioner Clem moved the Board approve the grant agreement between Wyoming Department of Health, Public Health Division and Campbell County for the Community Services Block Grant Program (CSBG) program to assist and support low-income individuals and families in Campbell County, in the amount of \$232,177 for the period of October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2025, as presented. Commissioner McCreery seconded the motion. All voted Aye. Motion carried.

Commissioner Clem moved the Board approve the contract between the Wyoming Department of Family Services and Campbell County to operate the Temporary Assistance for Need Family Community Partnership Initiative in Campbell County, in the amount of \$95,000 for the period of October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2025, as presented. Commissioner McCreery seconded the motion. All voted Aye. Motion carried.

Commissioner Jordan moved the Board approve the Order Approving the Petition for Formation of the Red Hills Improvement and Service District and Providing the Notice of Election Date on December 30, 2024, pursuant to W.S. §18-12-105 through 18-12-120. Commissioner Ford seconded the motion. All voted Aye. Motion carried.

Commissioner Ford moved the Board appoint Jeffery Vasalech and Wade Burr to the Board of Directors for the High County Improvement & Service District until the next election on May 5, 2025, as presented. Commissioner Clem seconded the motion. All voted Aye. Motion carried.
