Dwayne Dillinger provided an update on basketball gym floor water damage mitigation and repair. Discussion was held.

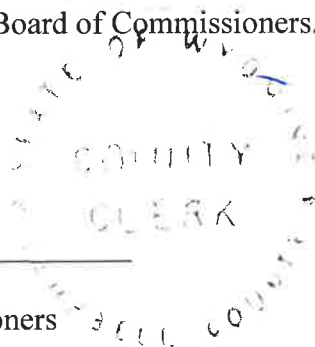
Dwayne Dillinger provided an update on the new pool liner.
