Discussion was held concerning a private donation for the Enzi Building and a request for funding from the county.

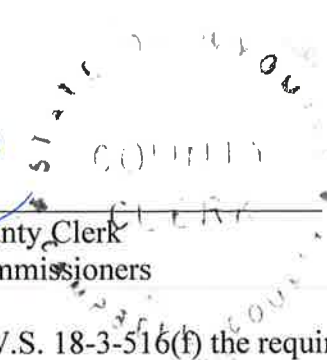
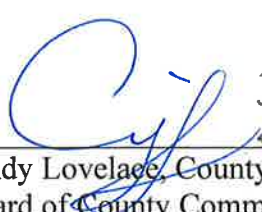
Discussion was held concerning the request by the GCCD Board of Trustees to transfer County owned buildings and property, currently used for Gillette Community College to GCCD.
