Special Meeting

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met in a Special Meeting, Wednesday, April 23, 2025, at 11:00 AM.

Workshop was held at Wright Town Hall concerning Wright Economic Development.

Commissioner Ford moved the Board approve the Change of Staffing Request for the Museum to change the Administrative Assistant Position from Part-Time to Full-Time Status, and approve the Position Vacancy Justification, as presented. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion. All voted Aye. Motion carried.

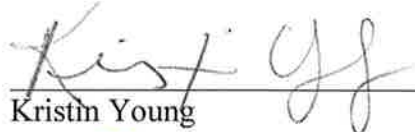

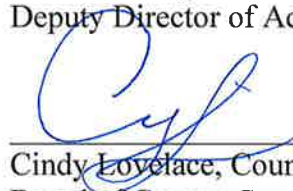
Workshop was held concerning the Pronghorn Industrial Project.
