The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met in a Special Meeting, Tuesday, July 15, 2025, and Wednesday, July 16, 2025. The purpose of the Special Meeting was to attend the Wyoming Community Days at the Idaho National Laboratory, 1955 N. Fremont Avenue, Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Present were Scott Clem Bob Jordan, Kelley McCreery, Jerry Means, Commissioners; Sandra Beeman, Executive Director of Administration; Cindy Lovelace, County Clerk. Commissioner Jim Ford was absent from the meeting.

The Idaho National Laboratory is owned by the United States Department of Energy and is operated by Battelle Energy Alliance.
