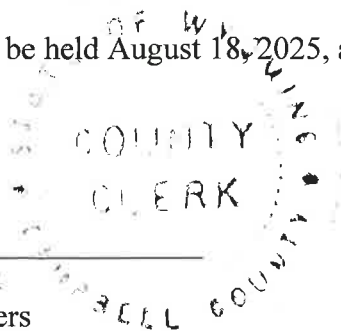
Discussion was held on the status of the FY2023-24 audit.
