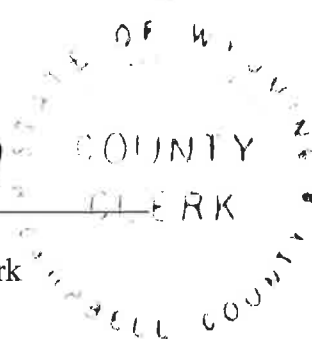
Commissioner Ford moved the Board approve the Change of Capital request from Public Works to reallocate FY2025 funds from the Pronghorn Industrial Sewer Project to the Bishop Road Relocation Project to close out the grant from Wyoming Energy Authority, in the amount of \$1,000,000, account 310084-67280, as presented. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion. All voted Aye. Motion carried.
