Special Meeting

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met in a Special Meeting, Thursday, September 11, 2025. The purpose of the Special Meeting was to meet the Cowboy Clean Fuels leadership team, receive a company overview and its economic impact, and visit the company's Triangle Unit operation site, located approximately 30 miles southwest of Gillette.

Present were Scott Clem, Jim Ford, Bob Jordan, Kelley McCreery, Jerry Means, Commissioners; Sandra Beeman, Executive Director of Administration; Kyle Ferris, Deputy County Attorney; Michelle Leiker, Deputy County Clerk; Ryan Waddington, Co-Founder and CEO of Cowboy Clean Fuels; Michael Urynowicz, Co-Founder and CTO of Cowboy Clean Fuels; Preston Anderson, CFO and COO of Cowboy Clean Fuels; Steve Farkas, EVP Business Development of Cowboy Clean Fuels.

Cowboy Clean Fuels uses their innovative method to leverage existing geological formations and native microbial ecosystems to generate sustainable energy while capturing and storing carbon dioxide. Cowboy Clean Fuels presented a company overview and its economic impact. A question-and-answer session was held. Commissioner Jordan did not attend the site tour and left the meeting.

The Board of Commissioners traveled to the Triangle Unit operation site at 10:15 AM. Members of the public were invited to attend the Triangle Unit Operation site tour on a first come, first served basis.
