### Adult Treatment Courts Board Meeting Agenda

**When: Wednesday July 19, 2023 @ 12:00 p.m.**

**Where: Adult Treatment Court Conference room**

Present: Judge Phillips, Greg Steward, Carly Hunter, Joseph Bolton, Janeice Lynch, Scott Mooney, Rhonda Stryker (via conference call). Staff present: Chad Beeman, Kolby Matheny, Scott Appley, Michelle Johansen

- I. CALL TO ORDER at 12:01 pm. Quorum present.
- II. Consent Agenda – Motion to Approve by Scott Mooney. Seconded by Janeice Lynch. Approved as presented.
- III. Staff Reports – Kolby Matheny: Felony side doing pretty good. One moved to Level 3 and one to Level 4. One of the Level 4s has relapsed. We are seeing how she does getting back on her feet. Newest Level 1 has been in and out of the hospital and relapsed. Probably won't have the treatment level for our program. Two or three more on my desk. One interviewee accepted. Two new ones yesterday. Two of our Level 4s that were violent offenders look to be doing a good job. Chad Beeman: Felony success rate is 78% for the last three years. Judge Phillips: More difficult cases are coming across my desk. People are now coming in on multiple possession charges. Scott Appley: Misdemeanor side is doing pretty good. One or two of them are more challenging. Chad Beeman: Misdemeanor success rate for the last three years is 88%.
  - a. Program Census: Felony: 13 / 9 DWI: Total : 22
    - # terminated or opted out: 0 Misd, 0 FEL
    - # screened and not admitted: 2 Fel , 1 Mis
    - # screened and accepted: 0- Misd. 1 Fel
    - # absconded: 1 fel
    - # graduated: 1 Misd
    - # pending: Felony Crt: 1 Misd Crt: 1
  - b. Budget/Revenue: Update will be presented. EOY board signature final statement - Chad Beeman reported we came in at 80% of the budget. Federal grant of \$28,000 was the big difference and our numbers were low at the beginning. Turned out pretty well.

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#### IV. Old Business:

- a. Director review bylaw change – Chad Beeman reported changes to Section 6 and changing his title from coordinator to director. Added that the director now reports to the Board instead of the Administrative Executive Director. Judge: Chad to look at HR verbiage. Chad Beeman: Reviews are done Octoberish. Motion to approve by Janeice Lynch. Seconded by Scott Mooney. Bylaw amendments approved. Judge: Years ago they used to get all the boards together. Asked Chad to set up something with a county HR person.
- b. ASI/ ASAM candidate requirement changes – Chad Beeman reported on highlighted changes. Misdemeanor 2.1 or lower. Felony strictly 2.1. Will be handled at the treatment team level, not by the board. Judge Phillips: Motion to approve language modification to paragraphs 5 and 6 for each program. Motion approved by Scott Mooney. Seconded by Joe Bolton. Handbook modifications Approved as amended.

#### V. New Business

- a. Coordinator call update – database, training - Chad Beeman reported a short meeting. The main discussion was the new database. Our old program has expired. Chad is on the subcommittee to give input. They are within a few weeks of going live. Looks like a much better system. Contract a year with the Department of Health to finish out the fiscal year and then it rolls over to the Judicial Branch.
- b. Mental health track- Chairman. – Judge Phillips reported an increase of people in the justice system having mental health issues. Idea is to create a diversion program. Moving them from prosecution to treatment. A pilot program here in Campbell County. Non-violent offenders but for their mental illness. Judge fox is pushing to get something going. Asking adult treatment court case managers help get it off the ground. Chad: Major concerns are funding it and training our staff.
- c. Change UA lab or testing process discussion. Chad Beeman reported that Norchem is taking a month plus to turn around results. Asking board's permission to look for another lab or purchasing an in-house lab. Permission to start shopping for a new lab. Fischer Scientific offers different levels of equipment. Janeice Lynch asked what does storage look like if they are fighting it? Judge Phillips: Treatment court level is a probable cause. Judge Phillips requested Chad email information to him as it becomes available.
- d. Tomorrow in Misdemeanor Court is Judge Castano's last day. Farewell to Judge Castano and welcome to Judge Bush.

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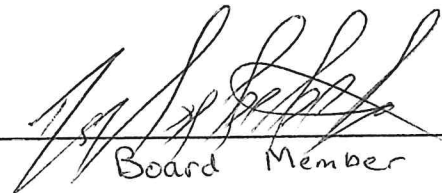
