- I. CALL TO ORDER: 12:05 p.m. Quorum present
- II. Consent Agenda: Motion to Approve by Greg Steward / Second by Janeice Lynch / Approved as presented.
- III. Staff Reports – Kolby Matheny felony: Doing okay, tough group. 4 or 5 to nutrition class mid-October, maternal leave 3rd time. Then be eligible to graduate sometime in December. Handful of potential parts. Three interviews, not all the paperwork is ready. November possibly to enroll. Strongest candidate in level 2 and couple in level 3. Judge Phillips: It is the responsibility of applicant however will touch base with the District Court Judges and prosecutors on timeframe. Chad Beeman: Once we get the orders in mailbox then ATC follows up on the applicant. Janeice Lynch wants to know if her office needs to follow-up more on their end. Chad Beeman: most applicants are usually in custody. Kolby Matheny: normal procedure is the applicant initiates then we contact individual and/or their attorneys. Janeice Lynch: District court sentencing without probation office initiating. Chad Beeman: Judge gives them the option in court during sentencing to contact Treatment Court without other entities involve. Scott Appley: one is really struggling, and the UAs are confirmed and will go to rehab. 2 will graduate in Oct. Everyone else is doing well. Pending – the individual took a plea to felony and will have to reapply, Excused the ones who have domestic violence. Judge Phillips said there are a few that he has come across, but they are violent.

IV. Old Business:

- a. Director review and staff reviews for Merit (executive session personnel)
- b. MH Diversion Track update: Judge Phillips going over the Mental Diversion: Judge Castano looking at it and cleaning it up. The council meeting and Judge Phillips will introduce the concept of the program. Correlation to MH and SI. Hoskinson group – private clinic on HWY 50 and initiatives that they are incorporating. Billing and information exchange. Couple individual in jail awaiting MH restoration evaluation - long standing diagnosis and substances use issues. Talking to state and defense counsel that he is a good candidate, and he has let out, but he gets reoffender so the right and the lawful thing to do. Hope is to start taking ppl the 1st of the year. Mentally ill that are in jail and need help to treat with medication to stop the cycle of jail/release. Greg Steward fit to proceed before we enroll. Judge Phillips: said no with or without representation of the individual to enroll. Doing it at any time. Fitness is something that is ethical for them to enroll in. Judge Phillips has been in contact with the father of the diversion program and gone over the pros and cons of who can, what are the restrictions, the process. Funding line open then we can start taking folks. Chad Beeman: Commissioner to sign off, the payment issues and who is staff. Oct 13th the next committee meeting.
- c. Drug testing Contractor update- Chad Beeman: Struggle with turn around on the results that is holding us up on those participants that have questionable results. Working with the IT depart that will be given us to have access to the internet that will be secure. \$50,000 for the unit options to lease it as well. Judge: has questions on what is used. Urine. Chad Beeman: Lab quality results and no questions on the \$20 for confirmation 48-72 hours confirmations. \$8 for a 20 – panel, Kratom is \$70, Alcohol is \$15. \$20 flat rate if we need confirmation. The maintenance is the question, and if we lose it then they still own it and update whenever. Cheyenne is using it for prescriptions. Judge wants to know if a def attorney wants to contest it...the confirmation is the accurate result, which can be subpoenaed. Main benefit immediately is the immediate results we get. Grant spec. Kristin Opioid settlement cost recovery will cover it. Kolby Matheny: the number of individuals with the increase of numbers then it is cost effective. Judge said useless to sanction someone who tested positive 6 weeks ago. The actual value is immediately. Scott Appley: over 90% of individuals are admitting. The problem that we are facing is Kratom, but the test takes up to 10 minutes or more to get the result. Judge says keep it up on the researching. Kolby Matheny: This company has the best facility to break down of the drug. Require full time person to run the tests, and to incorporate other agencies to utilize and help with funding. Judge: Present in laymen terms to the public at the meeting.

V. New Business

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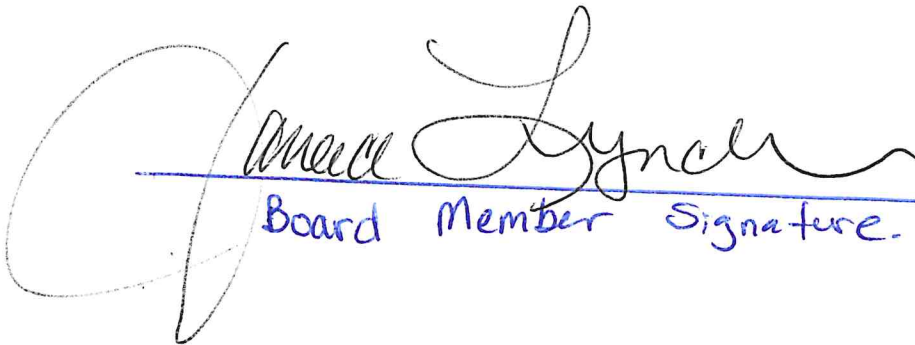

Interested in access to the funds, however unsure on how much to disburse and who is awarded the money.
