Denton Knapp discussed the Joint Dispatch area.

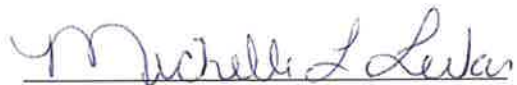
Chairman Shelstad discussed the House District 32 vacancy of Representative Timothy Hallinan.
